Vineyards

Located on the winery property in a unique small valley between the Dry Creek and Alexander Valley. There are two clones of Sauvignon Blanc, the Muscut Clone and Clone One. Each clone offers exquisite qualities to the wine.

Winemaking

The components for this wine were tank fermented separately, with different yeasts at cool temperatures for 3 weeks. The blend for this wine is equal parts Muscat clone and Clone 1, with 10% of the blend aged in neutral barrels for 3 months.

Tasting Notes

This vibrant Sauvignon Blanc bursts with aromas of mandarin orange spritz, floral notes and citrus blossoms, with underlying hints of limestone. Structured around bright refreshing acidity, flavors of white peach, crisp apple and Meyer lemon fill the mouth, finishing with a subtle grassy note.
