The fruit for the 2007 Fritz Winery Dry Creek Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from a vineyard that was planted in 1999. This vineyard is located on the eastern hillside midway down the Dry Creek Valley. The vineyard runs east-west down the hillside and is planted to clones 337 and 7 in sandy, gravelly soil.

Tasting Notes

Blended with a splash of malbec, this wine opens up with classic cabernet aromas of currants, black cherries and tobacco, with a hint of cola. The palate delivers flavors of blackberry, cassis and spices.
