

Fritz Cellars' Portfolio of Wines 2011 Estate Proprietor's Red Wine

Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2011 Estate Proprietor's Red is a blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Malbec. Aromas of red currant, ripe plum, wet gravel, and anise permeate throughout this full bodied wine. These same flavors follow onto the palate and are rounded with soft lingering tannins.

Production Notes:

The fruit was de-stemmed only so that whole berries were transferred to open top fermenters. This helps to capture bright fruit aromas and flavors. After a 5 day cold soak, the tanks were warmed and inoculated with yeast. The tanks were punched down 2-3 times daily, over 10 days, increasing skin contact. The wine was then drained off the skins and aged in 60% new French Oak for 18 months.
