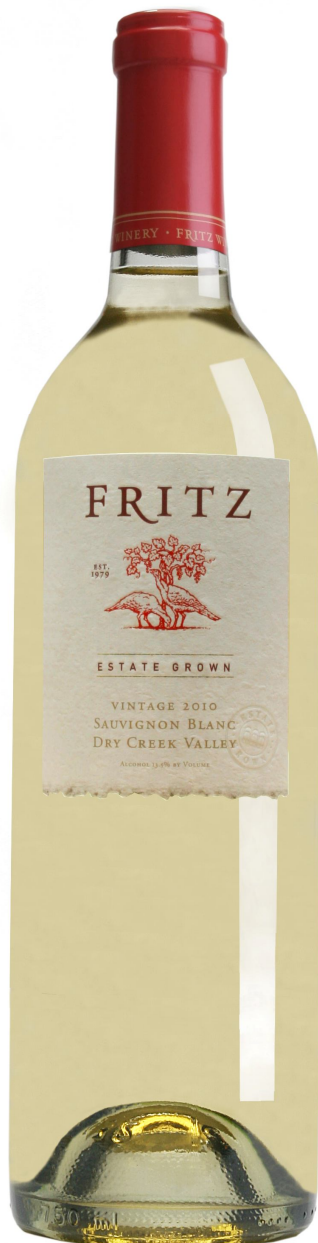

Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2010 Estate Sauvignon Blanc is the color of a ray of sunshine. This vibrant Sauvignon Blanc bursts with aromas of lemon zest, sweet pea flowers, and blood orange coupled with underlying hints of minerality. Beautifully structured it has refreshingly bright acidity. Flavors of tangerine, mango, and Meyer lemon fill the mouth. Look for a subtle grassy finish.

Production Notes:

The fruit for this wine was whole cluster pressed. 90% of the Sauvignon Blanc was tank fermented to enhance the aromatics and crispness inherent to the fruit. The remaining 10% was native barrel fermented in new French Oak to subtly soften the mouthfeel.
