2011 Estate Sauvignon Blanc

Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2011 Estate Sauvignon Blanc is the color of a sun bleached straw. This vibrant Sauvignon Blanc bursts with aromas of passion fruit, white peach and citrus blossoms with underlying notes of tropical fruits and limestone. Structured around bright refreshing acidity, flavors of white peach, guava and Meyer lemon fill the mouth, finishing with a subtle mineral note. With a light refreshing finish this is the perfect summer white.

Production Notes:

The fruit for this wine was whole cluster pressed. 90% of the Sauvignon Blanc was tank fermented to enhance the aromatics and crispness inherent to the fruit. The remaining 10% was native barrel fermented in new French Oak to subtly soften the mouthfeel.
