## Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2013 Estate Sauvignon Blanc is the color of sun bleached straw. This vibrant Sauvignon Blanc bursts with aromas of white peach and orange blossom with some underlying mineral notes. Structured around bright refreshing acidity, flavors of white peach, guava and green apple fill the mouth, finishing with a subtle mineral note. With a light and refreshing finish this is the perfect summer white.



## **Production Notes:**

The fruit for this wine was whole cluster pressed. 90% of the Sauvignon Blanc was tank fermented to enhance the aromatics and crispness inherent to the fruit. The remaining 10% was native barrel fermented in New French Oak to subtly soften the mouthfeel.
