

## Fritz Cellars' Portfolio of Wines 2013 Estate Zinfandel

## Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2013 Estate Zinfandel is produced from 8 acres of vines grown on our estate vineyard nestled in the hills of Dry Creek Valley. In this garnet hued wine, look for aromas of black currant, red cherry, blueberry pie, cardamom seeds, and cinnamon. It is a well structured Zinfandel with bright acidity and balanced juicy tannins. Flavors of black cherry, black current, rhubarb, and baking spices carry through to its delightful finish.



## **Production Notes:**

Whole berries were transferred to open top fermenters to help capture bright fruit aromas and flavors. The tanks were cold soaked for three days then warmed and inoculated with native yeast. Punch downs occurred in the tanks 2-3 times each day for 10 days, allowing skin contact for color. The wine was then drained off the skins and placed in 35% new American Oak barrels for 9 months.
