

Fritz Cellars' Portfolio of Wines 2014 Estate Rose

Winemaker's Notes:

Our 2014 Estate Rose is a blend of Zinfandel, Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon. An exquisite color of cotton candy, this Rose bursts with aromas of Maraschino cherry, peach, rose petal and subtle notes of cream soda. Bright, crisp acidity leads to flavors of straw-berry, cherry and a hint of cola on the finish.



Production Notes:

The fruit for our Estate Rose is de-stemmed and goes straight into a tank. After 3-4 hours of skin contact, the juice is drained and transferred back into a stainless steel tank, where it is fermented at 50 degrees F–55 degrees F for 2 to 3 weeks. This slow and cool fermentation helps to create our fruit forward Rose.
